Nearly everyone deleted or moved data so that we could be in compliance. Our personal data levels are cut in half and administrative accounts are now allowed a fraction of what we had before.

This has been a shock. Most everyone worked hard to comply. A very few were very ***upset*** ***and*** ***angry.***

Of course the problem has not be resolved by deleting a bunch of data. We are

a nonprofit and as such received a free service. But now that service is not enough and last fall could not be expanded. Recently it has become possible to buy data space, but it is very very expensive.

My department in the Mexico branch, will be meeting with my team to see how we manage our part of the problem.

Please pray for us as we confront this serious challenge.
